### Take control of the baggage

### How does it work?

An electric vacuum pump pumps out the air which creates the desired vacuum level. When a suction foot is placed airtight on a bag, the result is lower pressure. The difference in pressure makes the tube contract vertically and the object is lifted.

### Grips any bag - anywhere

The flexibility of TAWI's baggage lifter can grip almost any type of bag. No matter the fabric or size, it will lift bags up to 32 kg (70 lbs) in gauge, and out of gauge (OOG) environments up to 60 kg (132 lbs). The angle adapter allows the operator to angle the suction foot at ninety degrees to pick up bags from the side and the swivel allows for the baggage to rotate 360°. These built in features allow a wide variety of baggage to be handled safely, including backpacks and soft bags.

### Solutions for all conditions

The patented Low Head Room equipment allows unique and flexible solutions where ceiling height, narrow and confined areas with limited available working space may be an issue. Low profile crane systems, monorails, and carbon fiber arms are examples of how we provide our users with innovative answers to challenging airport environments.




